ABOUT BEAR NECESSITIES PEDIATRIC CANCER FOUNDATION

Bear Necessities Pediatric Cancer Foundation is dedicated to eliminating pediatric cancer and bringing hope and support to those who are touched by it.

Forty-three children are diagnosed with cancer every day, and cancer remains the leading cause of death from disease among children (National Cancer Institute, 2019). Although cancer impacts thousands of children annually, only 4% of the total federal funding spent on cancer research is directed toward the treatment of children (National Pediatric Cancer Foundation, 2019).



Therefore, it is critical to support pediatric cancer research to ultimately discover a cure, while continuing to help patients and their families today, bringing hope, joy, and happiness to those most in need.

Since Bear Necessities' founding 30 years ago, we have been providing customized experiences to brighten the life of a child living with cancer, helping thousands of children and families who have experienced this devastating illness. We also support cancer patients' families who are struggling financially by providing relief for grocery, transportation, communication, and utility costs. When we can help meet parents' most basic needs, they can focus on what matters most: their child.

Bear Necessities was founded in 1992 by Kathleen A. Casey and named in memory of her eight-year-old son, Barrett "Bear" Krupa, who died after a courageous five-and-a-half-year battle with Wilms Tumor. Prior to his death, Bear and his mother discussed and planned the formation of Bear Necessities. During his long stay in the hospital, Bear expressed more concern for other pediatric cancer patients than he did for himself. He and his mother learned that patients and their family members need support above and beyond standard medical care, and thus, Bear Necessities was born.

5 STEPS FOR FUNDRAISING SUCCESS

SPREAD THE WORD

- Share your fundraiser via social media, email, text, etc., inviting others to donate.
- If you're hosting an event, check out our posters to print and share:

- You can also create and print a free QR code that goes directly to your fundraising page at me-qr.com.

DECIDE WHAT & HOW MUCH

- Get creative and come up with a fundraising idea that will work best for you and your group. You can find some ideas on the next few pages.
- Set a fundraising goal, knowing every dollar matters. For example, it only costs \$20 to give a child a Barrett Bear, an adorable teddy bear that comforts children in the hospital.

FUNDRAISING IDEAS FOR ANYONE & EVERYONE

There are many ways to raise money. Whatever works for you, works for us!

• Donate Your Day

Celebrate your birthday, wedding, anniversary, or other special occasions by asking for donations instead of gifts.

• Turn Sweat Into Hope

Run, bike, climb or swim for children with cancer. Ask friends and family to support you or donate for every mile you conquer.

• Bake Sale

Put your culinary skills to work and sell goodies for children and families with cancer.

• Benefit Concert

Host a concert featuring a local band and donate proceeds from the tickets and concessions.

Dance-A-Thon, Bowl-A-Thon, Jump Rope-A-Thon, You Name It

Promote fitness and fun while changing lives.

• Movie Night

Host a movie night at school or in your neighborhood and donate proceeds from tickets and concessions.

• Tournament Time

Host a golf outing or challenge your family and friends to a free-throw contest, cornhole tournament, or any other friendly competition to raise funds.

FUNDRAISING IDEAS FOR SCHOOLS & COMMUNITY GROUPS

Rally your classmates or friends together for a fun activity and raise money so kids have the opportunity to feel like kids again.

• Loose Change

Encourage kids to gather loose change for a week, a month, or a year, and turn it into a donation.

• Classroom Competitions

This is a great option for younger students.

• Donate A Daily Habit

Ask fellow students and teachers to go without a daily luxury, like coffee or soda, and donate the amount they would have spent to Bear Necessities.

• Crafts or Student Art

Be creative and sell your crafts, artwork, or other creations.

Candy Grams

Sell bags of candy with a short note written by the buyer and deliver them to their selected recipient. This is great for the holidays like Halloween and Valentine's Day.

• Talent Show

Show off your magic tricks, dance skills, or best jokes and raise money for a great cause.

• Car Wash

Set up a car wash for your community and celebrate helping to end childhood cancer.





FUNDRAISING IDEAS FOR BUSINESSES

Need a good excuse for a team-building activity? Collect donations at the office and make a difference to families in need.

Office Games

Encourage some friendly competition with a desk chair relay, trivia game, or other fun activity.

• Donate A Daily Habit

Ask your colleagues to go without a daily luxury, like coffee or soda, and donate the amount they would have spent.

• Dress Down Day

Give team members the opportunity to play it casual in exchange for a suggested donation.

• VIP Parking Sale

There's always a prime parking spot in a workplace. Auction off exclusive parking rights to the spot for a week or a month and watch donations roll in.

Cook Off

Challenge your co-workers to a chili, bbq, dessert, 'you name it' cook-off, and ask taste testers for a donation.

Company matching! Be sure to ask if your company will match the amount raised by your fundraiser.


Ready to make a larger impact through a corporate donation?

HOW TO SET UP YOUR ONLINE FUNDRAISER

Visit donate.bearnecessities.org/forthekids

- Click Create a Fundraiser.
- Join as an individual fundraiser, start a team, or join a team that has already been created.
- Personalize your fundraising page.

Note: If you start a team, you will be team captain. You can set your fundraising goal and invite others to join your team. Everyone who joins a team will get their own individual fundraising page, and what you personally raise will go toward the team's overall goal.

After you register, you can edit your own personal fundraising page online to support Bear Necessities. You can log in any time to make edits using your username and password.

- Share the link on social media, via email, text, etc. Invite your network to support your fundraiser.
- Thank people as they donate.
- Keep asking and sharing until you meet your goal.

TIPS FOR SPREADING THE WORD:

- Send out emails and texts to friends and family, inviting them to join your efforts and contribute to your fundraising page.
- If you're hosting something in person, you can create and print a QR code that people can scan to make donations directly to your online fundraising page. You can also collect cash and checks to send to the Bear Necessities office.
- Don't be afraid to send multiple emails.
- Oftentimes people want to give but forget, so a reminder email is a great thing!
- Remember to share your personal story and why you are passionate about raising funds for Bear Necessities.
- Share a story of someone whose life has been changed by Bear Necessities. Check out social media pages to learn about the kids we've helped.





SOCIAL MEDIA TIPS:

- Share a link to your personal fundraising page and include one of our photos or graphics. You can find these resources at bearnecessities.org > Resources > Downloadable Content
- Post updates about your fundraising progress ask people to help you reach your goal.
- If you're organizing a fundraising event, create a Facebook event and invite people to attend. This is a great way to share details and photos of the event.
